The EIPA is an assessment designed to determine how effectively an interpreter works in the K-12 setting in terms of skill, clarity and facility with classroom discourse. While the workshop is geared toward K-12 interpreting, much of its content applies to interpreting a variety of community settings. This workshop, which employs samples from classrooms with realistic lectures and student participation, is designed to help you focus on the areas that you can develop in order to work successfully in an educational environment.
