Trinity Rep is accessible for patrons using wheelchairs, walkers, canes or crutches. Ample doorways, handrails in theater aisles, elevator service to the stage level of the Chace Theater, and conveniently located accessible restrooms make it easy to enjoy a performance at our theater.

Removable **seating** in both the Chace and the Dowling Theaters allow patrons to be seated with their companions while sitting in a wheelchair. Aisle seats are also available for those who wish to transfer to a theater seat. Please inform the ticket sales representative of your needs at the time of ticket purchase and indicate whether companion seats are required.

Open Captioned Performances



Trinity Rep will offer a number of open-captioned performances during the upcoming 2012–2013 season. Open captioning will be provided by c2 captioning service. Open captioning seats are available for \$22, and three-play subscriptions are available for \$66. To purchase tickets, call or visit the Trinity Rep box office. Open Captioning is live text displayed simultaneous to the performance on an LED screen at the front of the theater. As opposed to closed captioning, open captions do not require the user to have any special equipment for viewing the text and are always “open” to anyone. Assisted Listening Devices, which allow patrons to increase the volume of the performance to a comfortable level, are available free of charge.
