

## **RICDHH NEWS POLICY**

### **SUBSCRIBERS:**

Anyone can subscribe to receive RICDHH News and RI Community News by requesting that her/his name and her/his e-mail address be added to the e-mail distribution list for the RICDHH News and RI Community News. The subscriber, also, has the right to remove her/his name and her/his email address from the e-mail distribution list at any time. The e-mail addresses will not be sold, shared, or exposed by the RICDHH.

### **There are two types of news, RICDHH NEWS and RHODE ISLAND COMMUNITY NEWS.**

#### **1. RICDHH NEWS:**

RICDHH NEWS includes any news that is related to the RICDHH's activities, advocates, meetings, press releases, announcements, etc. All emails under RICDHH NEWS are endorsed by the RI Commission on the Deaf and Hard of Hearing.

#### **2. RHODE ISLAND COMMUNITY NEWS:**

RHODE ISLAND COMMUNITY NEWS includes any news that is obtained from outside of the RICDHH. This news will be distributed for the sole purpose of information sharing such as raising awareness, education, announcements, community events, research, trainings, meetings, etc.

The source of information and the disclaimer below shall be included in all RHODE ISLAND COMMUNITY NEWS to recognize that RICDHH is sharing this information for information purposes only and does not endorse the information. If anyone has concerns with this information, he or she should contact the original source as opposed to RICDHH.

The RICDHH reserves its rights to include any information to be shared with the subscribers through the RHODE ISLAND COMMUNITY NEWS.

Organizations, agencies, companies, or individuals may request that their information be shared with RICDHH e-mail subscribers. The information both the titles and contents must be free of any of the following:

- Sales
- Promotions
- Violence
- Profanity
- Nudity
- Religion

- Soliciting
- Hate Speech
- Any organization or agency, that receives federal and state funding, that does not offer protocols on how to request for accommodations at their events.
- Oppression and discrimination including sexism, racism, audism, phonocentrism, linguicism, heterosexism, and ableism
