



This card is for Law Enforcement officers to help with communication.

Quick Communication Tips:

- Get my attention first.
- Maintain eye contact with me while gesturing or speaking.
- I do not lip-read.
- Writing notes <u>MAY BE</u> helpful but not always.
 Use simple English.
- A cochlear implant or hearing aid does not allow me to understand everything.
- Avoid shining a flashlight in my face as this will hamper my ability to communicate.

If I am arrested or asked to come in for questioning, I will need:

- A Rhode Island licensed sign language interpreter.
- To make a phone call (high-speed internet connection and a computer, and/or my wireless device)
- Other accommodations. Please ask me what I need.
